

# Hotel Information

*Our hotels have been carefully chosen for their location, comfort, style and facilities. Mostly they are of four-star standard, but with good three-star hotels offered in some locations, particularly in the north, where the choice is more limited. All bedrooms have private facilities, TV and telephone. Most have mini-bars, but unfortunately tea and coffee-making facilities are not generally available in Scandinavian hotels.*

## Hotel Continental, Oslo

One of The Leading Hotels of the World this long established hotel is one of the very best in Oslo. Superbly located on Oslo's main street, the hotel offers two most attractive restaurants and a bar.

## Clarion Admiral Hotel, Bergen

Chosen for its splendid waterside location in the centre of Bergen, this comfortable three-star plus hotel offers restaurant, lobby-bar and a small harbour-side terrace. Bedrooms are of fairly modest size, but the lovely view across to Bryggen more than justifies the supplement of £40 per room per night for a Harbour-view room.

## Fleischers Hotel, Voss

A traditional family-owned hotel of great charm, beside the station and overlooking the lake. Facilities includes a beautiful restaurant, spacious lounges and terrace with panoramic views, bar, indoor swimming-pool, sauna, solarium, billiards and table-tennis. Deluxe lake-view rooms are available at a supplement of £60 per room per night.

## Kviknes Hotel, Balestrand

Owned and managed by the Kvikne family since 1887 this superior hotel has elegant lounges, bar, and attractive restaurant situated in the original hotel – built in 'Swiss Chalet' style. Bedrooms are mainly in the new wing. Fjord-view rooms are available with supplements from £40 per room per night.

## Brakanes Hotel, Ulvik

In attractive gardens leading down to the fjord this very pleasant hotel offers restaurant, lounges, bar, small indoor swimming-pool, sauna, solarium and rowing boats. The hotel's boat offers cruises into the Osafjord, and sea-plane trips are available (weather permitting). Fjord-view rooms are available at a supplement of £30 per room per night.

## Hotel Ullensvang, Lofthus

A superb, long-established, family-run hotel, on the edge of the fjord, with magnificent views of the Folgefonn Glacier. Facilities include restaurant, bar, lounges, indoor swimming-pool, sauna, jacuzzi, indoor tennis, squash, bowling, golf simulator, billiards and table-tennis, rowing boats, pedalos and bicycle-hire. Fjord-view rooms are available at a supplement of £50 per room per night.

## Hotel Alexandra, Loen

One of Norway's finest hotel, with a most attractive restaurant offering a sumptuous dinner buffet. Other facilities include an á la carte restaurant, piano-bar, indoor swimming-pool, tennis courts, and superb spa facilities with a variety of treatments and massages etc. at extra charge. Rowing boats and pedalos are available free of charge to enjoy the fjord. De-luxe fjord-view rooms are available at a supplement of £40 per room per night.

## Scandic Hotel, Ålesund

In a pleasant, water-front location in the heart of Ålesund, this modern four-star hotel offers an attractive restaurant, cosy bar and sauna. Superior sea-view rooms are available at a supplement of £30 per room per night.

## Rica Nidelven Hotel, Trondheim

A superb four-star hotel in a central riverside location. Facilities include restaurant, bar, sauna and fitness room. De-luxe river-view rooms are available at a supplement at £60 per room per night.

## Quality Grand Royal Hotel, Narvik

A pleasant, three-star hotel, located just a few minutes walk from station, shops and War Museum. Facilities include restaurant and bar.

## Copenhagen Admiral Hotel
